John Hawthorne Ufford, age 66, passed to be with the Lord Saturday, June 24, 2017 at his brother's home in Albertville after an extended illness. He had been an attorney for 26 years in Crossville, Alabama.

His practice covered DeKalb, Marshall, Etowah, and Cherokee Counties.
